DESCRIPTION

- "NLSP Buffalo": The following modification replaces any of the police cars in GTAIV with the New Liberty State Police Buffalo model provided.

REQUIRED PROGRAMS

- *OpenIV* (by GooD-NTS)
- OR
- *SparkIV* (by Aru)

INSALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Before proceeding, locate and BACKUP your "vehicles.img" file located in your "...\Grand Theft Auto IV\pc\models\cdimages" directory.
- Depending on what vehicle you plan on replacing, either preserve "noose" or rename the "noose.wtd" and "noose.wft" files provided to "police" or "police2" (all the while retaining the ".wtd" and ".wft").
- Use OpenIV or SparkIV to replace "police.wtd", or "police2.wtd", or "noose.wtd" inside "vehicles.img" with the corresponding ".wtd" file we have provided.
- Use OpenIV or SparkIV to replace "police.wft", or "police2.wft", or "noose.wft" inside "vehicles.img" with the corresponding ".wft" file we have provided.

NOTES AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

- The Buffalo model provided is a version modified by Lt.Caine from the original "FIB Buffalo" by Rockstar Games.
- The vehicle's main texture is made by Lt.Caine.
- The vehicle has a completely customizable main skin.
- The vehicle possesses two "extra" parts, a Code 3 MX-7000 light bar, and a set of interior deck lights. (Both can be toggled on or off using C06alt's VehicleSelector).
- The light bar used on the vehicle is a version modified by Lt.Caine from the original Code 3 MX-7000 light bar made by Schaeft.
